- Scholarship applications and supporting documents must be received no later than **Thursday**, April 15, 2021.
- Applicants must submit three (3) letters of recommendation (*teacher, principal, counselor, minister, community member, or employer*).
- Applicants must have a 3.0 overall GPA or higher.
- Applicants must attach a copy of their ACT and or SAT scores.
- Applicants must have scored at least 18 (*composite*) on the ACT or 970 on the SAT.
- Applicants must attach an official copy of his or her high school transcript
- Applicants must attach a color headshot (*photograph of yourself from neck up*).
- Applicants must include a one-page Biographical Sketch highlighting your life, career goals, and how you spend your spare time.

Application Review:

- Applications will be screened. Applicants who meet the requirements and become candidates for a scholarship will be contacted via telephone or email to be scheduled for an interview.
- **Only selected finalists will be notified**. Applicants who are awarded scholarships will be notified in **May 2021.**
- In order to receive funds for the 2021-2022 school year, students, or their parent(s)/guardian(s), must submit a letter from the office of the registrar of the college or university with the official raised seal by **October 22, 2021.**

He or she has demonstrated discipline, leadership skills, and academic achievement. It is preferred but not required that the applicant plans to enter the field of science.

PURPOSE:

To promote and encourage the perpetuity of our Historical Black Colleges and Universities.

CRITERIA:

- Applicants must be a graduating high school senior living in or graduating from a school in one of the Eta Iota Omega Chapter's service areas of *Western Wayne County.* (Inkster, Dearborn Heights, Romulus, Taylor, Wayne, Westland, Belleville, Canton, Ecorse, Garden City, Northville, Plymouth, and River Rouge.)
- Applicants must have demonstrated leadership qualities, be disciplined and academically astute.
- Applicants must also include a one-page typed **biographical sketch** of your life, highlighting your career goals and how you spend your spare time.
- Applicants must have a **3.0** overall GPA or higher.
- Applicants must submit three (3) letters of recommendation from a teacher, principal, counselor, minister, community member, or employer.
- Applicants must have scored at least 25 (*composite*) on the ACT and 1200-1220 on the SAT.
- Applicants must attach a copy of their ACT and or SAT scores.
- Applicants must attach an official copy of their high school transcript.
- Applicants must attach their headshot photograph (color picture requested).
- Applicants must matriculate into an accredited four-year college or university designated as a **Historically Black College or University** in the fall term of 2021.
- Scholarship application and supporting documents must be received by **Thursday, April 15, 2021.**

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

- All essays, letters, and required documentation will be read and evaluated by the Scholarship Committee. Qualifying candidates will be contacted by telephone or email to be scheduled for an interview.
- **Only selected finalists will be notified**. Applicants who are awarded scholarships will be notified in **May 2021**.
- In order to receive funds for the 2021-2022 school year, students, or their parents/guardians must submit a letter from the office of the registrar of the college or university with the official raised seal by **October 22, 2021.**

He or she has demonstrated discipline, leadership skills, and academic achievement. It is preferred, but not mandatory that the applicant intends to enter a college or university with an established ROTC Program and transition into a branch of the armed forces.

PURPOSE:

To encourage honorable service to this great country through military service.

CRITERIA:

- Applicants must be a graduating high school senior living in or graduating from a school in one of the Eta Iota Omega Chapter's service areas of *Western Wayne County.* (Inkster, Dearborn Heights, Romulus, Taylor, Wayne, Westland, Belleville, Canton, Ecorse, Garden City, Northville, Plymouth, and River Rouge.)
- Applicants must have demonstrated leadership qualities, be disciplined, academically astute, and currently involved with the high school's JROTC Program.
- Applicants must submit a well-written and typed seven hundred and fifty-word essay on *"What it Means to Serve Our Country through Military Service."*
- Applicants must also include a one-page typed **biographical sketch** of your life, highlighting your career goals and how you spend your spare time.
- Applicants must have a 2.5 overall GPA or higher.
- Applicants must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from a teacher, principal, counselor, minister, community member, or employer and (1) letter of recommendation from the JROTC Officer in charge.
- Applicants must attach a copy of the ACT and or SAT scores.
- Applicants must have scored at least 18 (composite) on the ACT or 970 on the SAT
- Applicants must attach an official copy of *his or her* high school transcript.
- Applicants must attach a color headshot (*photograph from neck up*).
- Applicants must matriculate into an accredited college, university, community college, trade, or vocational school in the fall term of 2021.
- Scholarship application and supporting documents must be received no later than **Thursday, April 15, 2021.**
